

ORDINANCE NO. 18.0

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS  
OR LOTS IN THE CITY OF ROYALTON.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROYALTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. ANY HOUSE, PLACE OF BUSINESS, OR STRUCTURE  
(WHICH IS PRIMARILY USED AS A DWELLING) ON  
A LOT WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS MUST HAVE A  
NUMBER, EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER PASSAGE  
AND PUBLICATION ACCORDING TO LAW.

SECTION 2. NUMBERS MUST BE VISIBLE FROM THE ROAD. PLACE  
THEM OVER THE FRONT DOOR, OR IF THAT IS NOT  
VISIBLE, PLACE THEM ON THE SIDE OF THE HOUSE,  
PLACE OF BUSINESS OR STRUCTURE, NEAR THE FRONT  
DOOR.

MINIMUM SIZE OF NUMBERS MUST BE FOUR (4) INCHES  
HIGH, NUMBERS MUST BE MOUNTED NO LESS THAN  
FIVE (5) FEET HIGH FROM THE GROUND. ALL  
NUMBERS MUST BE IN NUMERICAL FORM. IF NUMBERS  
ARE WRITTEN OUT THEY MUST ALSO BE MOUNTED IN  
NUMERICAL NUMBERS. (SUCH AS: ONE HUNDRED  
TWENTY FIVE AND ALSO 125).

INFORMATION AS TO WHAT NUMBER IS REQUIRED  
MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE CITY CLERK, CITY  
HALL.

SECTION 3. PENALTY. VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL  
BE DEEMED TO BE A PETTY MISDEMEANOR SUBJECT  
TO A MAXIMUM PENALTY OF A \$100 FINE.
